About the Program

In 2013, Wisconsin passed law to allow post-conviction relief for individuals arrested, prosecuted or convicted of crimes because of having been a victim of human trafficking. Pro bono attorneys and LOTUS Legal Clinic have been working to vacate convictions for trafficking survivors since 2015. In partnership with LOTUS Legal Clinic, the American Bar Association Survivor Reentry Project will offer this free training to introduce attorneys to Wisconsin's vacatur remedy for trafficking survivors, explore best practices, and familiarize participants with the Project's resources for defenders, pro bono attorneys, advocates and directly impacted individuals. The training will provide a foundation upon which pro bono attorneys may represent survivors under Wisconsin's law.
