

Virtual Writing Workshop for Survivors of Sexual Violence November 7-8, 2020 12:30 pm to 4:00 pm (both days)

Poetry of Witness. Writing as Therapy. Art and Advocacy.

Organized by LOTUS Legal Clinic in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Untold Stories is an educational program that consists of writing workshops, poetry readings, art exhibitions, a literary magazine, and a community showcase. The mission of Untold Stories is to bring empowerment and healing to survivors of sexual violence and human trafficking by helping them to find their voice and develop skills to become agents of systemic change.

Led by Austin M. Reece, Director of Survivor Empowerment at LOTUS Legal Clinic, and novelist Dr. Deb Brenegan, this two-day Zoom writing workshop will focus on writing poetry in response to trauma and the healing aspects of literary art. It will also include a special session on how to write your legislator led by activist and advocate Katerina Klawes.
